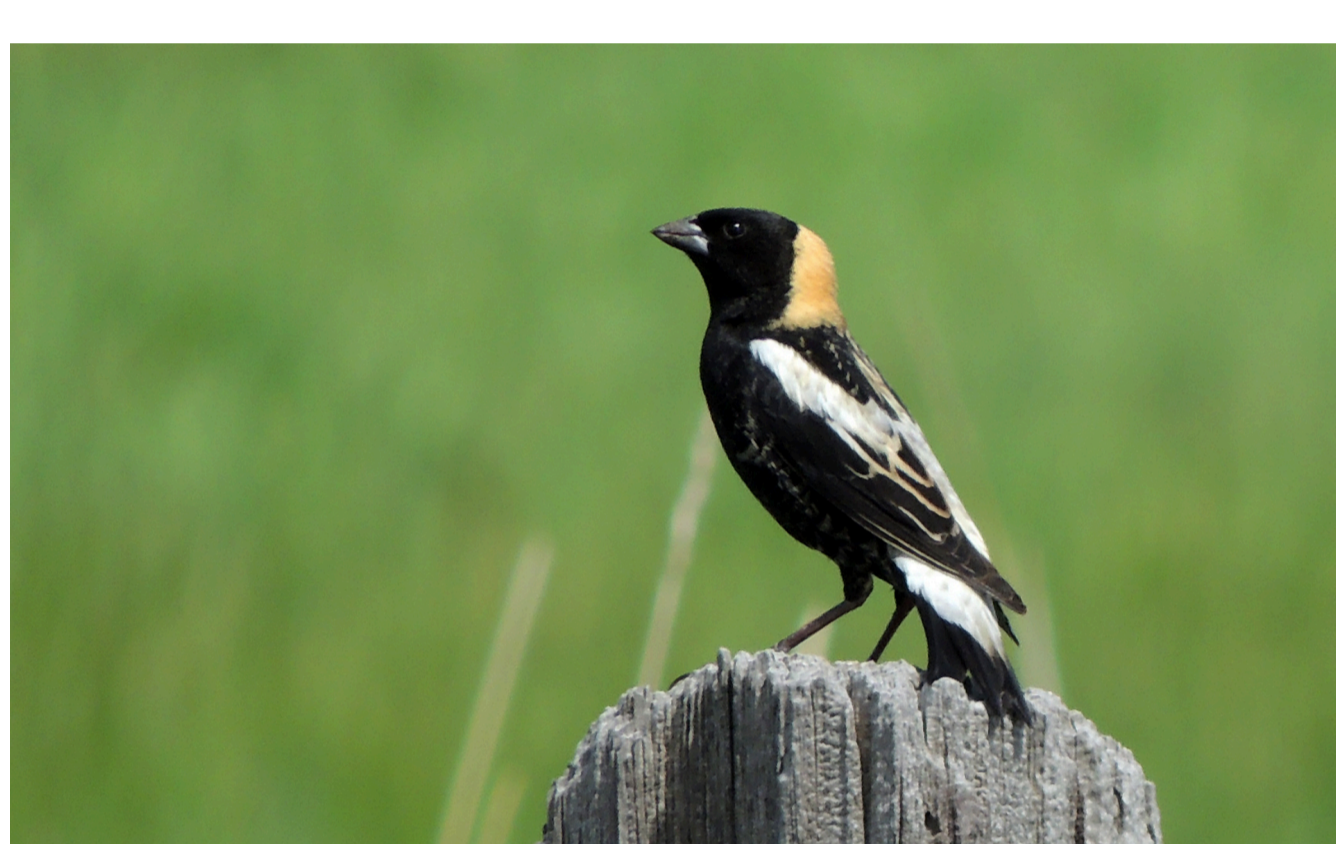
Where Rising Voices Resonate

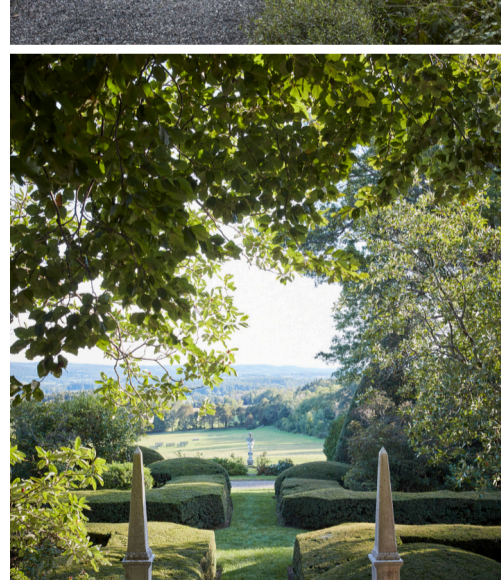

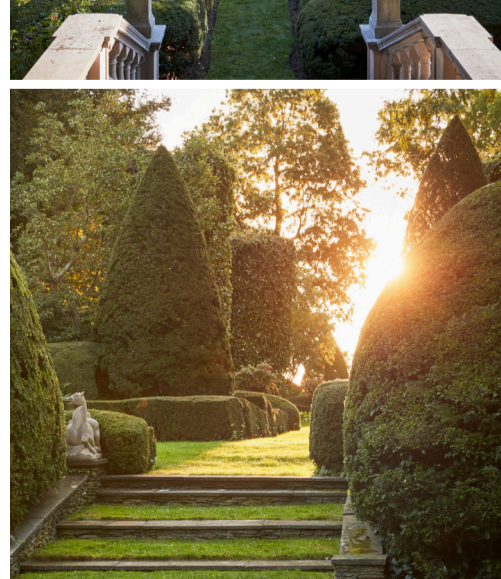
