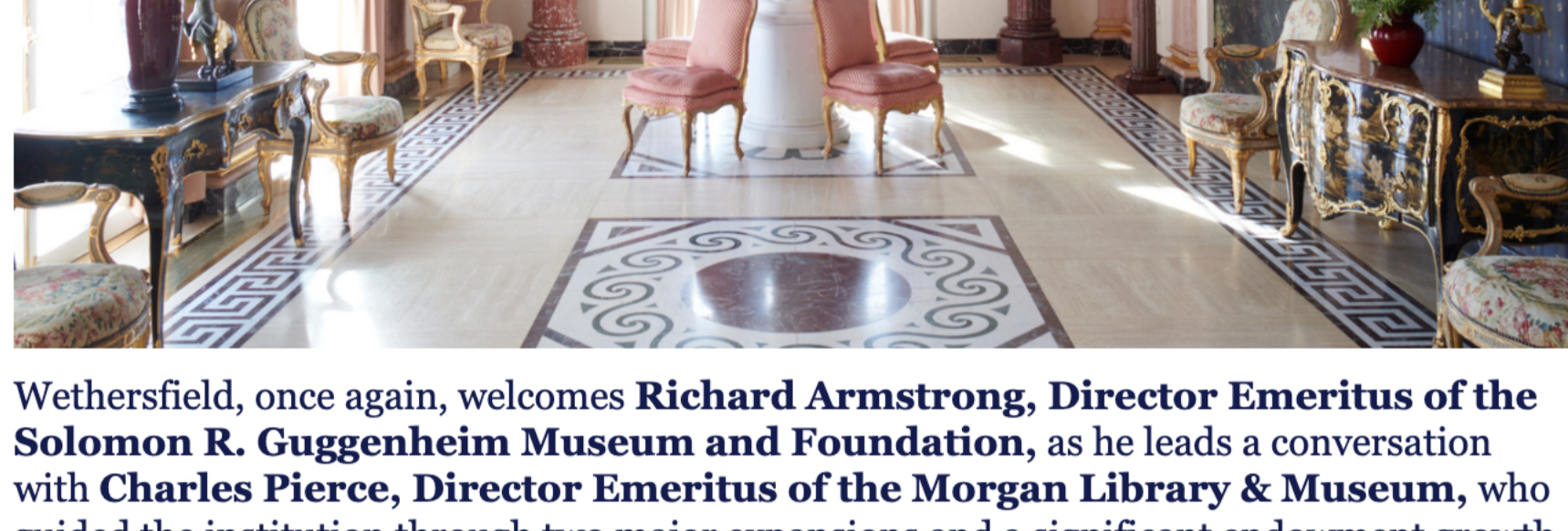
Conversations with Cultural Luminaries in our Community Conversations at Wethersfield, Speaker Series with Richard Armstrong featuring Charles Pierce

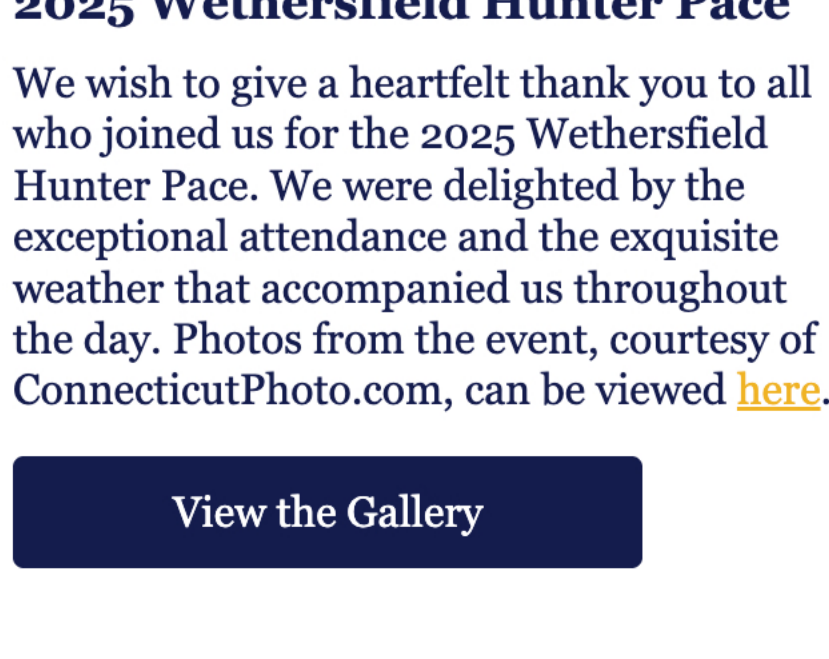
