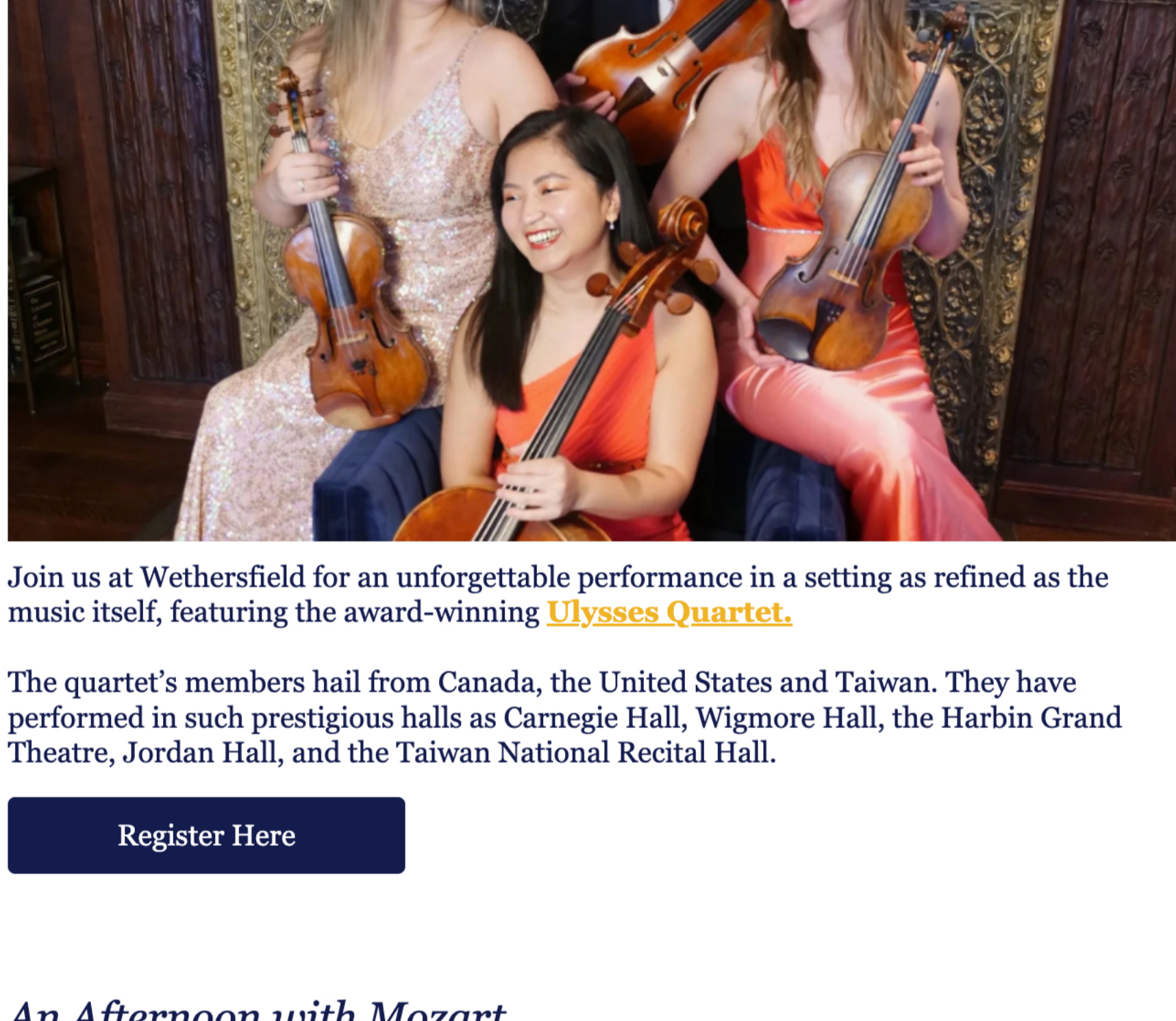

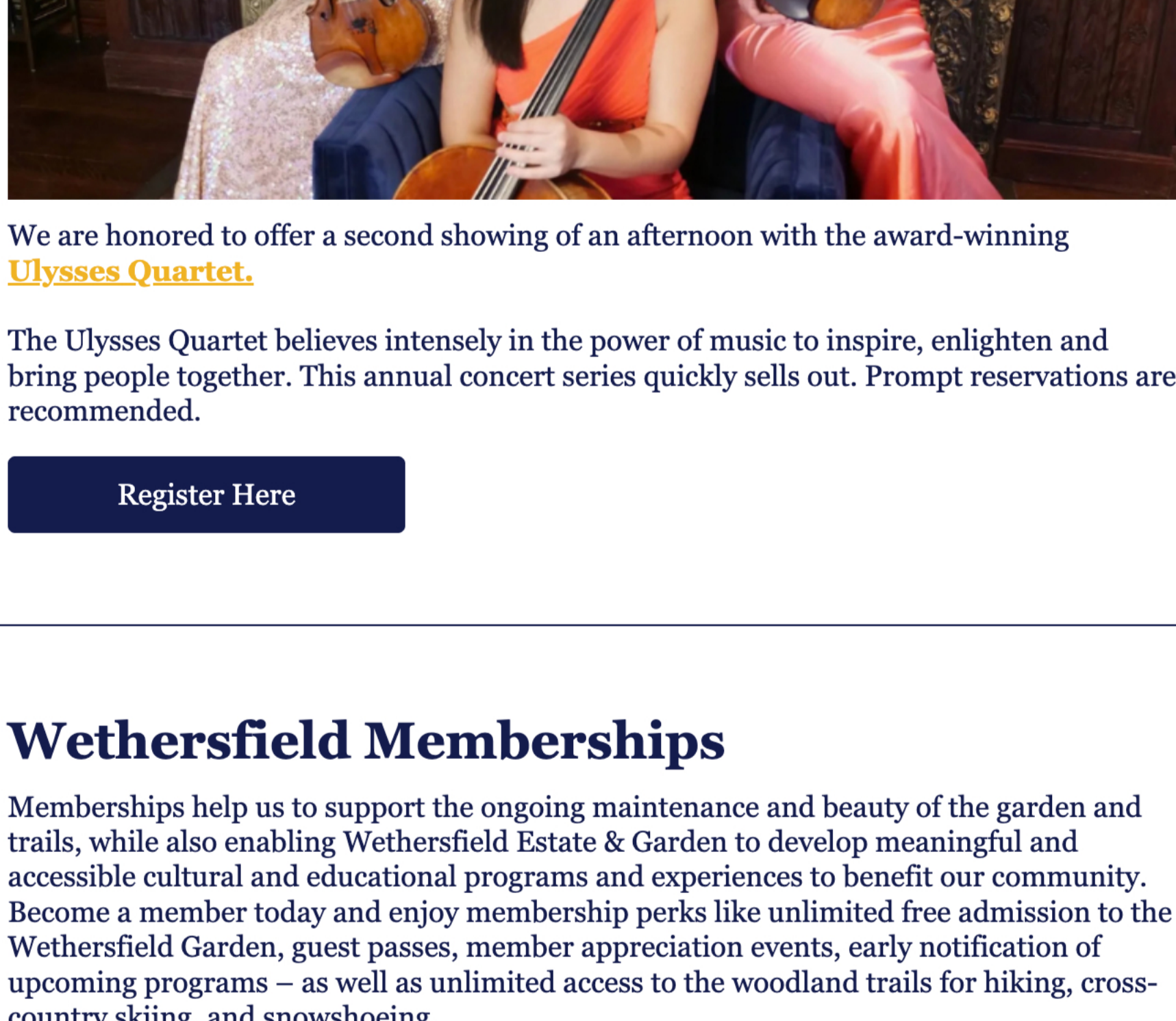
Join us at Wethersfield for an unforgettable performance in a setting as refined as the music itself, featuring the award-winning **Ulysses Quartet**.
